

HIV SCREENING



Do you know what disease prevention is and why it's important? Well, we are here to give you that information. Medicare pays for many preventive services to keep you healthy. These preventive services can find health problems early, when treatment works best, and can keep you from getting certain diseases.

HIV Screening is one of the preventive services that is covered by Medicare.

Who's covered?

Medicare covers HIV (Human Immunodeficiency Virus) screenings if you meet these conditions:

- You're 15 – 65, not at risk and ask for the screening.
- You're younger than 15 or older than 65, at an increased risk for the virus, and ask for the screening.

How often is it covered?

Medicare covers this test once every 12 months, or up to 3 times during a pregnancy.

You pay nothing for this test.
